



BENVENUTO! A welcome from the President of Festa Italia Foundation Joe Cardinalli.

This year, 2023 we celebrate the 90th Anniversary of the Festa Italia Santa Rosalia Fisherman's Festival. We gather with family and friends on the Custom House Plaza next to the Monterey Bay Historic Fisherman's Wharf to celebrate and share Sicilian-Italian Culture, Cuisine and Family connections. In 1933 the tradition of the blessing of the Fishing Fleet and praying for the safety of the fisherman to Santa Rosalia was established. The four women credited with establishing the ceremony are Francesca (Ferranti) Giamona, Giovanna Balbo, Rosa Ferrante and Domenica Enea. Central to the celebration was always the thought that the lives and ships of the fishermen were to be protected from the dangerous sea through the intercession of the patron saint: Santa Rosalia. The Festa Mission remains to honor those men and women who left their homes in Sicily and established new lives in the State of California. Their cultural heritage and labors contributed to the growth of the City of Monterey and the establishment of Monterey as the "Sardine Capital of the World".

I always get asked this question, which Cardinalli are you, are you the car guy, no, I'm the "a-I-I-i" guy, so here is my super condensed family story:

SHARING MY FAMILY STORY ... My father, Steve Cardinalli was a fisherman, he was born in Pittsburg California on August 26,1913. My grandfather, Nonno Andrew Cardinalli, was born in Isola delle Femmine, Sicily and immigrated to Pittsburg CA, my grandmother, born in Sicily, Nanna Jennie (Ursino), also immigrated to Pittsburg California. They met in Pittsburg married

and had a family of 12. When my dad was about 8 years old my Nonno and Nanna moved the family of 12 children (6 girls and 6 boys) from Pittsburg to Monterey in an old truck, my Nonno supported his family as a fisherman. My Mother, Josephine (Josie Russo) was also born in Pittsburg, California, her sisters were: Frances, Angelina and Jenny. My Grandmother, Elinora Russo (Aiello) moved them from Pittsburg to North Beach Columbus Ave, in San Francisco. As children, my Father and Mother lived just around the corner from each other in Pittsburg.

During World War II my Father worked in the ship yards in San Francisco, Steve and Josie met, fell in love and married, the war ended and my father and mother moved to Monterey to be near the Cardinalli Family. My father was a fisherman and a truck driver, he owned and operated "Steve's Bait" delivering fresh fish and bait up and down California. Later in life my mom and dad owned and operated a motel on Fremont Street in Monterey and a motel on Munras Avenue known as "Carmel Hill" motel row. I have one older brother Andy, who is four years older than me. When I was about 8 I learned how to build Fish Boxes from my dad to help earn extra money for the family. This probably was the beginning of my carpentry skills. When I was a little older I accompanied my dad on his truck route delivery bait up the Sacramento River. The trucks in the 1950's are not the trucks of today, they were cold, smelled of gas fumes, hard riding and you could see the roadway through the floorboard cracks near the gear shift knob. This is just a little of what I remember as a kid growing up in Monterey, we had a great life as kids playing under fisherman's wharf jumping back and forth on the big purse seiner skiffs and all day playing outside until it was too dark to see and we had to go home. Today with my wife Marilyn we continue to have a great life, I wouldn't change it for the world. Enjoy the 90th Festa Italia Santa Rosalia Fisherman's Festival. Viva Santa Rosalia,



Mike Marotta and Friends


BOCCE Ci vediamo al campo de bocce!

Bounty of the Sea Exhibit

Located at the Stanton Center





The Festa Italia Foundation in partnership with the Italian Heritage Society has created a time-line exhibit of the history of fishing in Monterey Bay—Bounty of the Sea—the exhibit includes text, photos and stories. The exhibit emphasizes the Sicilian/Italian contributions made during the sardine era that led to Monterey earning the title of Sardine Capital of the World. The display covers the Pittsburg connection, the Santa Rosalia ceremonial blessing of the fleet, the Festa Italia Celebration, a Tarantella traditional dress along with information on fishing boats, nets, canneries and the wharfs. It also highlights information on Indigenous, Chinese, Portuguese, and Japanese fishermen, the Western Flyer, and the Monterey Bay Fishing Trust.

The exhibit is located at the Monterey History and Art Stanton Center at the Custom House Plaza. Viewing is available daily from 10 am to 5 pm, except Fridays. Admission fees are charged.







History of Bocce

- The first documented history of the game was in 5200 BC in a painting in an Egyptian tomb.
- Bocce spread through Palestine and by 600 BC was adopted by the Greeks, who passed it on to the Romans.
- In 1319 AD, Bocce was prohibited from play by anyone of lesser than noble status, as it was feared that it took too much time away from practical endeavors and military training.
- By 1519, the game once again became public and spread to places like Belgium and Holland.
- The Republic of Venice condemned the sport in 1576 and the Catholic Church prohibited clergymen from playing bocce.
- Guissepi Garibaldi, sometimes referred to as the George Washington of Italy, popularized the sport and made it what it is today whilst unifying Italy.
- In 1896, the first Bocce
 Olympiad was played in
 Athens, Greece. It has been
 an international sport ever
 since.
- The first bocce clubs were formed in Italy and the first recorded Italian league was established in 1947. This was also the first year of the annual Bocce World Championships.





Directions Fisherman Wharf Cioppino Serves 8-10

Ingredients

- 3 Cups Marinara
- 1/2 Cup Butter
- 2 Tbsps. Garlic, minced
- 1 Cup Clam Juice
- 1 Cup White Wine
- 1/2 lb Cod cut into 2" chunks
- ½ lb .Swordfish- cut into 2" chunks
- 6 ea. .Scallops
- 6 ea. . Prawns
- 1/2 lb Dungeness Crab Legs Cracked at the joints
- 6 ea. Clams
- 6 ea. Mussels

- 1. Melt the butter in a large, deep sauté pan.
- 2. Add the garlic and stir together over medium heat.
- 3. Add the marinara, clam juice and white wine and stir to incorporate for 5 minutes
- 4. Carefully add all fish and shellfish to the marinara and combine.
- 5. Cover and simmer together for 15-20 mins. Serve with some crusty garlic bread and a glass of Monterey County Chardonnay.

Saint Rosalia HER STORY















Who was Santa Rosalia? She was born in 1130 AD and is the Patron Saint of Palermo, Sicily. According to legend, Rosalia was born to a Norman noble family that claimed descent from Charlemagne. Devoutly religious she abandoned her family's wealth and royal lifestyle to live as a hermit in a cave on Mount Pellegrino, where she died alone in 1166. Tradition says that she was led to the cave by two angels. There she lived as a hermit dedicating her life to prayer and solitude.

According to her story, a ship carrying the bubonic plague landed in Palermo in May 1624. The epidemic that ensued caused the deaths of about one third of Palermo's population. The epidemic raged on until the middle of July when a young man, Matteo Bonello, had a vision in which Rosalia appeared to him and directed him to her cave. She instructed him to retrieve her bones and to carry them to the four corners of the city. Bonello found the cave, Rosalia's bones and a rock with Rosalia's name on it. He carried the bones to the city and soon Palermo's horrible plague was over. Santa Rosalia became the patron saint of the City of Palermo. In fact, she is generally revered throughout Sicily.

Every July 15-17, Palermo holds a festival to commemorate the ending of the plague and to honor their patron saint. The annual festivities are elaborate and attract people from great distances. The Community of Isola delle Femmine is a mere 15 kilometers from Palermo. Many of the original Isola delle Femmine immigrants participated in Palermo's annual festivals bringing the tradition to Monterey.

In 1933, the tradition of blessing the fishing fleet and mass at San Carlos Cathedral followed by Saint Rosalia traveling in a procession to the Monterey Wharf was established. As Santa Rosalia traveled from the Cathedral she is led by the Local Catholic clergy, Knights of Columbus, the congregation and community members. Upon arriving at the waterfront, the names of those lost at sea are read aloud and a wreath is placed in their honor. A blessing is offered for all who make their living on or by the Monterey Bay.

Santa Rosalia's float is adorned with fresh flowers donated in honor and memory of fishing families. There are a limited number of spots available. If you are interested in honoring a family member, please contact Phyllis Grillo at pgrillo831@gmail.com 0r (831) 402-8030

No Italian wedding or celebration is complete without the rhythmic song and dance to the Tarantella. It is considered by some to be the most popular of all the Italian songs and it is even considered by many as the song of Italy. The dance is both lively and graceful, with light and quick steps mixed with passionate gestures.

The Tarantella, originally an Italian folk dance of the lower-middle-classes. Has been labeled as a dance to cure sickness. Legend states that between the 15th and 17th centuries an epidemic of tarantism swept through the town of Taranto of

southern Italy. This was as a result of being hit by the poisonous tarantula spider. The victim, which is referred to as the tarantata, once bitten would fall into a trance that could only be cured by frenzied dancing. People would surround the victim while musicians would play mandolins, guitars and tambourines in search of correct rhythm. Each beat would have a different effect on the tarantata causing various movements and gestures. Once the correct rhythm was found it was almost certain that the tarantata was cured.

The Tarantella Dancers perform on Saturday and Sunday
